1. Objective

GEM offers an outstanding, high-quality viewing experience that preserves original artistic intent. Achieving this level of quality requires GEM to work with source files that match the original frame rate and aspect ratio as originally shot and mastered. If you do not have the source materials GEM requests, GEM will work closely with you to determine whether acceptable alternatives are available. In this document, GEM may be referred to as “GEM” or “our,” and Partner may be referred to as “you” and “your.”

For each Title, all Source Material elements set forth in this schedule must work in conjunction (conform) with one another as a properly functioning single asset. Source Material must be compliant with the specifications detailed in this document.

This document lists specifications for deliverables to GEM. Some specifications may not apply to your production. Please refer to your GEM Delivery Requirements List or your GEM representative to confirm which sections apply to your delivery. If any section of this document appears to conflict with the Partner Help Center, please defer to the GEM Delivery Requirements List for the Title or your GEM representative.

2. Core Principles

- All delivered elements must conform to the same final locked cut: picture, audio, and timed text must match frame-accurately.
- Deliver the native frame rate and native aspect ratio of the finished master. Do not standards convert or change cadence unless specifically approved.
- Deliver one continuous file per program (feature) or per episode. Do not split into reels.
- Dialog subtitles must be delivered as separate timed text files. Do not burn dialog subtitles into picture.
- No watermarks, timecode burns, slates, ad markers, broadcaster bugs, distributor logos, or platform branding.

3. General Asset Requirements

- Deliver the uncensored master unless GEM explicitly requests an edited version.
- Do not perform frame rate conversions, pulldown, interpolation, or re-timing unless GEM approves an alternative.
- Do not add letterboxing or pillarboxing unless it is part of the creative master.
- No bars/tone/leader/slates in the program master unless requested for a specific workflow.
- Timed text must not be burned into the program master (dialog subtitles).
- Translation integrity must be preserved; avoid altering meaning or tone beyond required localization.
- For animation or content with intense flashes, patterns, or strobing, Partner must disclose any PSE/flash concerns and provide test results if available.
- All elements must match the final locked picture master. If any element is based on a different cut, disclose immediately.

5.2 File Integrity

- For large deliveries, provide a simple manifest listing all delivered filenames and file sizes.
- If a delivery uses a transfer service that supports checksums, ensure uploads complete successfully and are not modified after upload.
- If GEM requests it for a specific delivery, provide a checksum file (MD5 or SHA-256) per asset.
- Redeliveries must clearly indicate what changed and which files are replaced.

Audio must be free of clipping, distortion, dropouts, clicks/pops, and phase issues (especially in downmix).

- Accurate transcription/translation and punctuation.
- Clean cue timing and readable pacing; avoid rapid-fire cues.
- No watermarking, ads, or platform branding.

- For CC/SDH, include meaningful non-dialog cues where appropriate.

Episodic	Series name, season number, episode number, episode title
Editorial	Short synopsis (1–2 sentences), long synopsis (1 paragraph), genres, 5–10 tags
Credits	Director, producers, writers, main cast, key crew (as available)
Technical	Runtime, resolution, frame rate, aspect ratio, SDR/HDR, audio formats delivered, timed text languages delivered
Rights	Clearance confirmation for music/archive; territory limitations if any

10.1 Artwork Specifications

Artwork must be free of embedded borders, watermarks, and platform branding.

11. Audio Description (As Requested)

If GEM commissions Audio Description (AD) for a Title, GEM will provide specific instructions and timelines. When requested, deliver AD as separate WAV file(s) that conform to the final picture master. Naming conventions and delivery format will be confirmed in the GEM Delivery Requirements List for the Title.

12. File Naming Conventions (Required)

12.1 Naming Rules

- Use underscores; avoid special characters.
- Use consistent season/episode notation: S01E01.
- Keep names human-readable; avoid long strings.
- Include format and key technical traits when helpful.

14.2 Redelivery Expectations (Guidance)

Severity	Expectation	Typical Examples
Blocking	Acknowledge within 7 business days; redeliver as soon as possible	Wrong frame rate; missing audio; clipping; burned-in subs; out-of-sync subs
Non-Blocking	Track and correct in a future delivery where feasible	Minor metadata typos; minor caption punctuation

14.3 Common Fix Required Issues

Category	Examples
Cadence / Frame Rate	Wrong frame rate, standards conversion, cadence artifacts
Aspect / Scaling	Incorrect aspect ratio, unintended letterboxing/pillarboxing, improper resizing
Picture Quality	Macroblocking, banding, unintended flicker, gamma shift

Audio	Missing WAV deliverables, clipping, incorrect mapping, out-of-range loudness
Timed Text	Burned-in subs, out of sync, wrong start time, missing required languages
Branding / Slates	Watermarks, slates, bars/tone, distributor bugs
