



# Situational VFX Delivery Specifications

## 1. Introduction

- Some productions may require additional VFX Wrap Assets not covered by core Post Production Branded Delivery Specifications.
- Refer to your production's Delivery List and GEM representative to confirm requirements.

## 2. Situational VFX Wrap Assets

### 2.1 Promo Materials

- Provide material suitable for Behind-The-Scenes (BTS) footage or stills in native capture format or best available quality/resolution.
- Include Before & After, Work In Progress (WIP), or test reels with vendor/facility info.
- Archive marketing/trailer finals or awards submissions in formats requested by Marketing/PR/Awards teams.

### 2.2 Background Plates

- Provide footage/stills in native capture format or best quality.
- Include generic plates such as driving scenes, helicopter/drone shots, environment plates.
- HDRI lighting reference files must be clearly named and organized in folders with accompanying elements (e.g. skies, aerial plates).
- VFX plates must be in:
  - 16-bit EXR (.exr) with ACES or Camera Linear color pipelines; uncompressed or lossless ZIP/PIZ compression.
  - 16-bit DPX (.dpx) for Camera Log pipelines.
  - 10-bit DPX (.dpx) only if primary capture was 10-bit Log.
- LOG EXRs and zipped files/directories not accepted.

# GEM

- Follow GEM VFX Best Practices and VFX Plate Naming Best Practices.

## 2.3 2D Elements

- Provide footage/stills in native capture format or best available quality.
- Include generic real-world filmed elements, excluding computer-generated imagery.
